

GUIDELINES FOR SELECTION OF INMATES FOR ADMISSION INTO SATS SPORTS INSTITUTIONS

- I. **Selection Dates** : Is Informed before one Month

- II. **Age** :
 - a. **For Sports Schools:** Eligible age for Sports Schools: Admission into 4th Class, the child should be 8 years of age and Admission into 5th class, the child should be 9 years of age for participating in the selections.

 - b. **For Sports Hostels:** 10 years age group of boys & girls will be selected based on the score obtained in the battery tests of motor ability. The candidates who scores maximum points on order of merit will be considered for admission depending upon the vacancies.

 - c. **Academies:** Below 16 years (Lower age group can also be considered for Gymnastics) basing on the seats.

 - d. **Selection Committee:**
 1. Nominee from SATS
 2. International Player / Sports Celebrity of the Discipline concerned
 3. DYSO / Administrator of concerned institute
 4. The Secretary of the State Association of the Discipline concerned
 5. Senior Coach of the Discipline concerned
 6. Academy Coach of the Discipline concerned

Guidelines for Hostels & Academies:

- e. **Automatic Admissions:**

The admission under this category will be extended only on availability of Seats.

For individual Events :

- (i) Sports Persons who obtain first 04 (four) positions in individual events at the :
 - National Games;

- National Championships (relevant age groups) held by National Sports Federations (NSFs) yearly (once a year);

Shall be given automatic admission in the concerned sports discipline in any one of the Academies.

OR

(ii) Sports Persons who obtain First and Second position in individual events at the :

- All India School Games Federation Competitions;
- Inter-State Competitions organized by NSFs (yearly);
- Inter-Zonal Competitions held by NSFs (yearly); and
- All India Circuit Meet/Permit Meet organized by NSFs

Shall be given automatic admission in the concerned sports discipline in any of the Academies.

OR

(iii) Sports Person who obtain first 02 (Two) positions in individual events at the State Championships organized by State Sports Associations shall be given automatic admissions in the concerned sports discipline in any of the Academies.

(iv) The admission may be made after proper age verification and medical examination.

For TEAM Events :

(i) Any of the team members of the team who are placed First, Second and Third in the following competitions :

- National Games;
- National Championships (relevant age groups) held by NSFs yearly (once a year);

Would be provided automatic admission in the concerned sports discipline in any of the Academies.

OR

(ii) Sports Persons who are the members of the team winning First and Second position at the :

- All India School Games Federation competitions;
- Inter-Zonal competitions organized by NSFs; and
- All India Federation Cup organized by NSFs.

Would be provided automatic admission in the concerned sports discipline in any of the Academies.

OR

(iii) Sports Persons who obtain First 02 (Two) positions at the State Championships organized by State Sports Associations (once a year) would be provided automatic admission in the concerned sports discipline in any of the Academies.

OR

(iv) Sports Persons who have represented State in the National Championships organized once a year by the concerned NSF would be provided automatic admission in the concerned sports discipline in any of the Academies.

(v) The admission would be provided after age verification and medical examination.

f. Admission of Trainees with Extra-Ordinary Height :

Special consideration may be given of trainees with extra-ordinary / exceptional height for various games and sports where height / specific anthropometric requirement plays a vital role to achieve higher level of performance. The Sports include Volleyball, Basketball.

<u>Age</u>	<u>Boys</u>	<u>Girls</u>
Under 14	above 165 cms.	Above 160 cms
Under 16	above 175 cms.	Above 165 cms
Under 16	above 182 cms.	Above 170 cms

And they may be admitted directly, limited to 10% of the strength of respective Academies. The admission would be made after age verification, medical examinations and through assessment of potential. In addition to the above the specific skill shall be tested and achievements shall be take into consideration for the admission into Sports Academies.

The final listed Sports persons will be extended tentative admission as per the recommendation of the Selection Committee and with the approval of the VC&MD, SATS.

GUIDELINES FOR SPORTS SCHOOLS:

Mandal Level Selections:

The Mandal level selections may be held at the Mandal head quarters concerned and the M.E.O., is in-charge of entire procedure. The children will be short listed for District level selections on the basis of scoring the maximum points at Mandal level on order of merit basis from the following tests as per the schedule:

Documents to be produced:

- a. Age & Study Certificate from present school
- b. Birth Registration Certificate from MRO & Panchayathi / Municipality / Corporation
- c. Ten latest passport size photographs
- d. Copies of progress reports of class III & IV

The selection procedure for admission into class IV is 3 tier system i.e.,

1. Mandal level selections
2. District level selections
3. State level selections

The entire nine motor quality tests may be conducted in the Mandal level with the help of DSA coaches and Physical Education personnel. The test results should be announced by the MEO and the call letter for the District level selections will be issued by the MEO on completion of the selection of the same day by not exceeding 20 boys @ 20 girls for IV class. In case of tie, younger age child will be given preference.

District Level Selections:

The District level selections may be held at the District head quarters concerned and the DYSO is in-charge of entire procedure. The children will be short listed for State level selections on the basis of scoring the maximum points at district level in order to merit basis from the following tests as per the schedule:

The entire nine Motor quality tests along with medical & age verification tests will be conducted at District level. The tests results should be announced by the DYSO and the call letter for the State level selections will be issued by the DYSO on completion of the selection on the same day by not exceeding 20 boys & 20 girls for IV class and 20 boys & 20 girls for V class in case of tie, younger age child will be given preference.

State Level Selections:

The State level selections shall be conducted in Telangana State Sports School, Adilabad premises in the following tests.

a) Anthropometric

- Height
- Weight

b) Motor qualities

- 30 mtrs. Flying Start
- Standing Broad Jump
- 6 x 10 mtrs. Shuttle run
- Standing Vertical Jump
- Flexibility (forward bend and reach)
- 1 kg Medicine ball put
- 800 mtrs Run

c) Medical

- Age verification
- Norms for age Verification

If the student's certificate age and doctor's assessed age difference equals to one or more years he/she should be disqualified and his/her name will be omitted from merit list.

- Posture
- Bony abnormalities
Norms for Bony abnormalities: if the student have the below abnormalities.

- a. Knock Knee (++)
- b. Flat Feet (+)
- c. Spinal disorders
- d. Heart Problems
- e. Bow legs (++) & correlated with Battery Test
- f. Any other specific abnormalities

Then he/she should be disqualified and his/her name will be omitted from merit list.

Note:

Submission of different study certificates, different date of birth certificates and studying other than the class for which the selections are conducting will be treated as disqualification and omitted from preparation of merit list.
